Key Facts:

Some sectors of the authority suffer disproportionately from crime, most notably the more urban areas of Beverley, Bridlington and Goole, as well as the more residential area of Haltemprice. However it is Bridlington which continues to have the highest crime rate per capita, with rates nearly three times that of neighbouring Driffield and Hornsea. The map gives a more detailed geographical analysis of crime in the authority for the year 1998-9.
