Key Facts: Since 1995, the number of pupils with statements has risen from 211,307 to 252,857, a national increase of just under 20%, although the overall percentage of pupils with statements has remained relatively stable at around 3% of the pupil population. In the Yorkshire and Humber region the number of pupils with statements has increased by more than 27%. Hull and Doncaster were the only LEAs in the region to experience a fall in statemented children during this period. More than half of these pupils, 60%, are educated in mainstream schools.
