Key Facts: This PAF indicator attempts to compare the level of home care services provided to people with a learning disability across local authorities. The rates per 1000 were lower than we expected in three of our four local authorities. Anecdotal evidence suggests that neither daycare nor supported living services have been included in the calculations, although RAP data should encompass this in the future. The figure for North East Lincolnshire also suggests some major inconsistencies in counting methods. It will be interesting to see how these figures develop as the RAP data set rolls out across all local authority social service departments. See definitions for data sources and health warnings.
