Key Facts: National Performance Tables provide a crude snapshot of the exam performance of pupils. The expected standard for 7 year olds in the national test is a level 2 or above. Level 2 is graded further into three bands, a b, & c, where 2b = an average level 2. The table above gives the scores for each LEA in the Yorkshire and Humber Government Office Region, as well as aggregate regional and national figures. As the results show, East Riding of Yorkshire is above the regional and national average for both reading and writing.
