Key Facts: In some agency contexts, the term adult refers to people aged 16-64, whilst in others adulthood is generally defined as beginning at 18 years of age. In order to provide denominators which are useful to all agencies, (for example, for PAF or RAP indicators), we have included 16-64 and 18-64 year-olds in this set, as well as more detailed tables of people aged 65 years or older.
