Key Facts: The number and distribution of people with disabilities resident in the city is not known. However, benefit agency data gives some indication of the size and whereabouts of those people in receipt of disability benefits. This data, based on a snapshot of claimants in May 1998, indicates that Orchard Park, Sutton and Noddle Hill wards contain the largest numbers of severely disabled claimants of working age, which is probably related to the type and range of accommodation available in these areas. These wards also rank amongst the top 10% most income deprived wards in the country. Access to key services in these areas has also traditionally been poor, placing this group of disabled people at risk of social isolation and exclusion from essential services.
