Key facts: This table shows the distribution of private registered daycare within the local authority. In March 2001 there were no fewer than 2674 private registered daycare places in the local authority. Half of these were private nursery places and less than a quarter were with childminders. The area with the highest level of provision per 1000 under 5's were the central and western areas of Myton, Newland and Avenue. In contrast, the less prosperous areas of Marfleet, Noddle Hill and Orchard Park had an average of 5 places per 100 under 5's.
