**Key Facts:** According to local estimates, the number of 75+s has grown much more slowly in this authority than nationally, with an estimated increase between 1991-9 of just under 4%, with a further 6% growth anticipated by 2021. The wards with the largest number of resident 75 year olds and older include Derringham, Ings, Boothferry, and Holderness, where older people exceed 1100 in number. People aged 75+ represent some of the most vulnerable residents in the authority. According to a recent survey, approximately half of older people aged 75+ who live in private households, live alone, (SHHA). This group of pensioners are heavily reliant on state benefits for their income and are more likely than others to experience persistent poverty. Nationally it is estimated that close to half of all lone 75+ may be eligible for state financed residential care. See definitions for data sources and health warnings.
